A friendly reminder to renew your ASCE membership for 2023 if you have not done so already. Thank you, and I look forward to seeing you all next week at Michael Baker International.

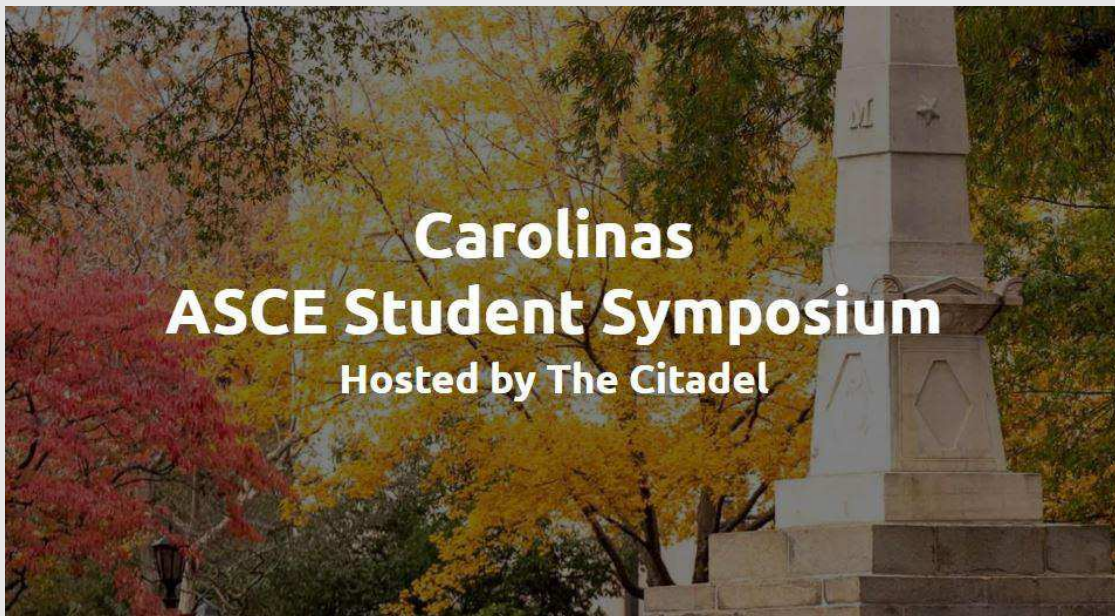

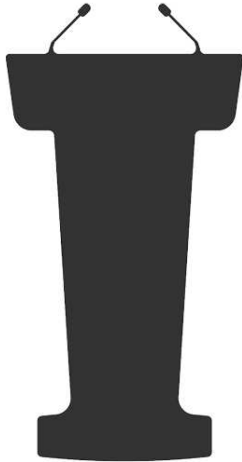
